

Criteria for returning Timber Scallops and Frames

Timber Scallops and Frames are used to transport our pipes safely to our customers. Iplex can accept Timber Scallops and Frames used in pipe packaging with minimal damage for reuse or repurpose using the “220mm rule”.

220mm Rule: If your Timber Scallop or Frame is starting to break or crack, provided it is longer than the required length of 220mm, Iplex can still repurpose it.
