









Recycle your Timber Frames and Timber Scallops Here!

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Whole timber frames (with strap or no strap) – Must be strapped onto a pallet on pick-up. • Any good Timber Frame with minimum length of 220mm • Cracks on Timber Frame edges are OK if they are longer than the minimum length. • Undamaged Timber Scallops (no cracks or breaks) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Damaged or cracked timber scallops • Any random timber (must be the standard pipe timber frame from pipe packaging of pipe timber scallops) • Damaged timber frames that cannot be cut back to the minimum length of 220mm • Fittings with metal attachments • General wastes
 <p><i>Complete frames, strapped onto a pallet are acceptable</i></p>	 <p><i>Random bits of timber are not acceptable</i></p>
 <p><i>Individual Timbers must have nails removed or flattened</i></p>	 <p><i>Individual Timbers must have their nails removed or flattened</i></p>
 <p><i>Damaged Timbers are OK if it can still be cut down to a minimum 200mm of good timber</i></p>	 <p><i>Any timber less than minimum length of 220mm</i></p>
 <p><i>Scalloped Timbers must be whole and have no crack or damage</i></p>	 <p><i>Any cracked, damaged, or broken scalloped timbers are not acceptable</i></p>

If your timber is starting to break or crack, provided it is longer than the required length of 220mm, Iplex can still repurpose. Fill out the contact form on our website and we can take care of the rest.
